Annual Notice to Parents and Staff of
Brea Olinda Friends Christian School:

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986 (AHERA) requires elementary through secondary schools to identify asbestos-containing material in school buildings and take appropriate action to control the release of asbestos fibers, where applicable.

As you may know, asbestos was used for many years in building materials because its properties made it ideal for insulating, sound absorption, fireproofing and a variety of other uses. The EPA banned most uses of asbestos as a building material in 1978. Each school that falls under the jurisdiction of AHERA is required to inform parents and staff annually that an Asbestos Management Plan is on file, available for viewing by anyone who asks to see it.

The initial inspection of our campus reported that no asbestos-containing building materials were found. Most of our elementary classrooms were built after the prohibition of asbestos-containing building materials. This notice is provided for compliance reasons only.
