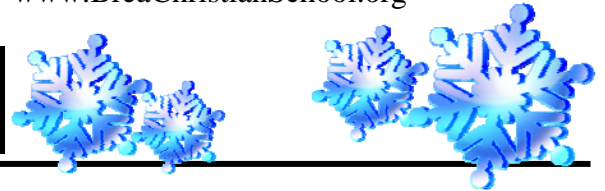

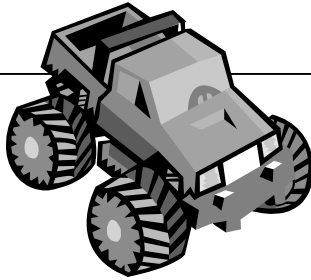
### Recipe For A Happy Child
