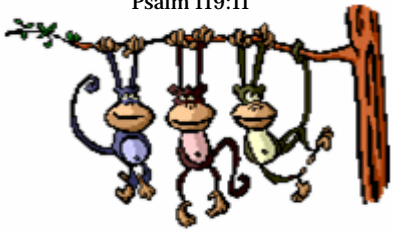

How Dehydration Affects Children

American History

On this day in 1776, the Declaration of Independence was approved by the Continental Congress declaring independence from the Kingdom of Great Britain, starting the 13 original colonies on the road to freedom as a sovereign nation. The major objection to being ruled by Britain was taxation without representation. The colonists had no say in the decisions of English Parliament.

In 1776, Thomas Jefferson presented the first draft of the declaration to Congress. It was adopted on July 4th. The Declaration was signed by most delegates in August, one month later. Remarkably, both Thomas Jefferson and John Adams (the only two men who signed the Declaration of Independence to become president) died on the same day: July 4, 1826, which was the United States' 50th anniversary. I see God's handprint on that one. God Bless America!
